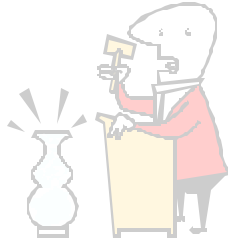

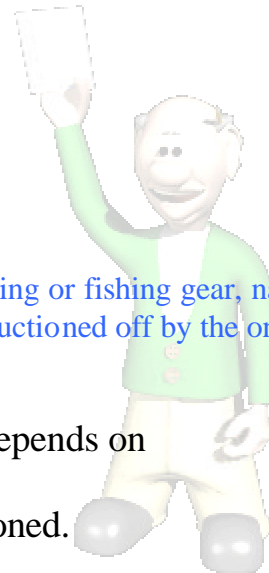

Auction details: Bring your unused or unwanted boating or fishing gear, nautical clothing, books, supplies etc. to be auctioned off by the one and only Brian Smith.

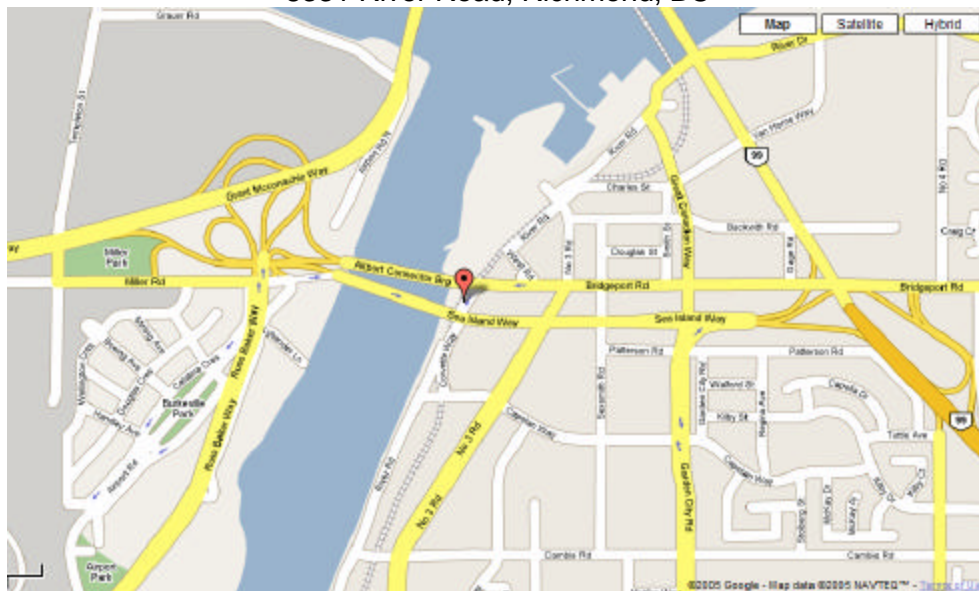
