The evening's speaker is LIEUTENANT COMMANDER T.N. KENNEDY, he transferred to the Regular Force Navy as an Acting Sub-Lieutenant in 2000. Lieutenant Commander Kennedy has had many operational deployments including OP Apollo, OP Unison, OP Sextant, OP Sirius, OP Active Endeavour and most recently, OP Allied Protector.

You will likely have seen the news coverage regarding Her Majesty's Canadian Ship Winnipeg's counter-piracy operations off the Horn of Africa in the Gulf of Aden last spring. While deployed, HMCS Winnipeg operated as part of a NATO Maritime Group and contributed to the safety and security of ships from around the globe sailing through those waters. Through April and May, the Canadian crew took part in the NATO-led counter-piracy mission Operation Allied Protector. Winnipeg, along with warships from the United States, Spain, Portugal and the Netherlands, interdicted pirates operating in international waters off the Horn of Africa.

In addition to maintaining a patrol presence with other coalition ships, Winnipeg escorted numerous merchant vessels and ensured the safe delivery of more than 5.000 tons of life-saving humanitarian assistance to Somalia in support of the United Nations' World Food Programme. The success of this dynamic operation reflected the strength of the 240 sailors and aircrew who made up the ship's company as well as the strong leadership and vision of Winnipeg's Commanding Officer, Cdr. Craig Baines.
