Recipe Corner

Crab-encrusted Halibut

meat from 1 Dungeness crab (I just used the body meat and save the large leg pieces for my steak the next day)

- 1 c. Panko breadcrumbs
- 1 c. freshly grated parmesan cheese
- 1 tbsp. minced fresh tarragon
- 1/3 c. melted butter
- 4 pieces of Halibut (no skin)

Method

In a medium bowl combine the breadcrumbs, parmesan cheese, crab and tarragon. Drizzle in the melted butter a little at a time, stirring well to evenly coat the breadcrumbs. Rinse the halibut and

dry well with paper towels. Grease a cookie sheet or I use parchment paper. Put the halibut on the parchment and spread the crab mixture evenly over the halibut. Bake on the middle rack for approx. 10 minutes at 40 degrees. Serve immediately. Decorate with 4 fresh sprigs of tarragon on the halibut and lemon wedges on the side to impress your friends. A glass of sauvignon blanc goes well with this recipe. Rose Easthom
